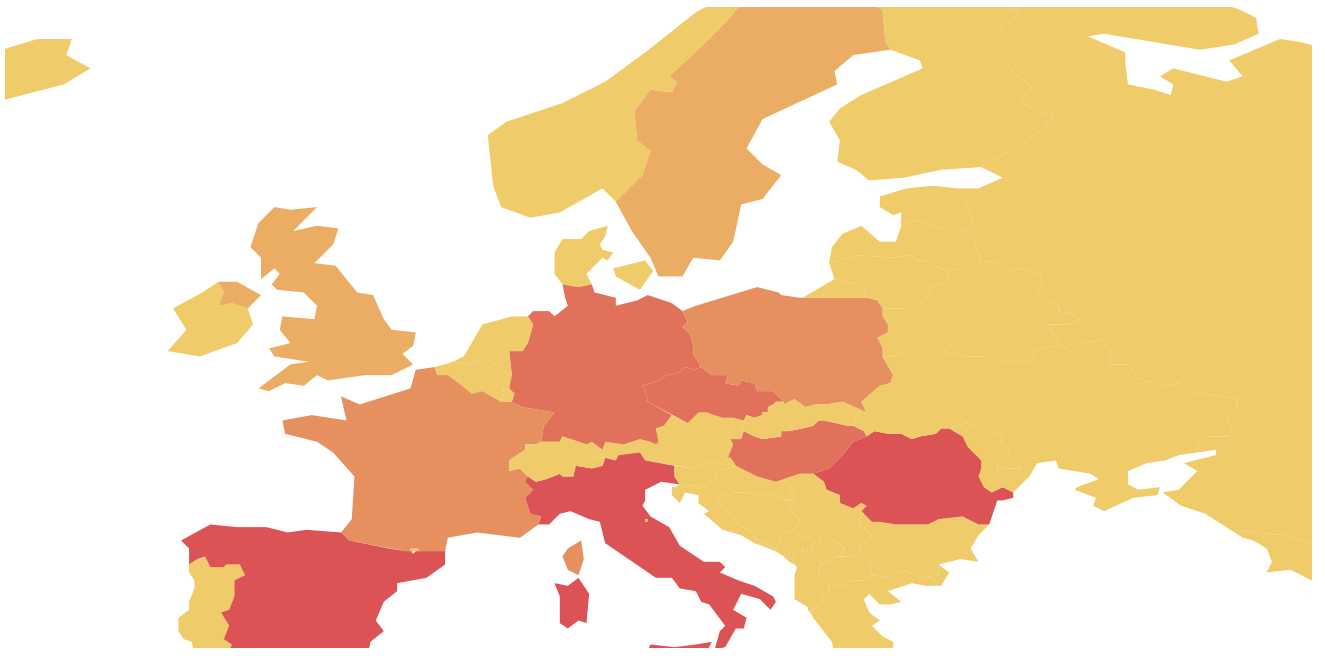
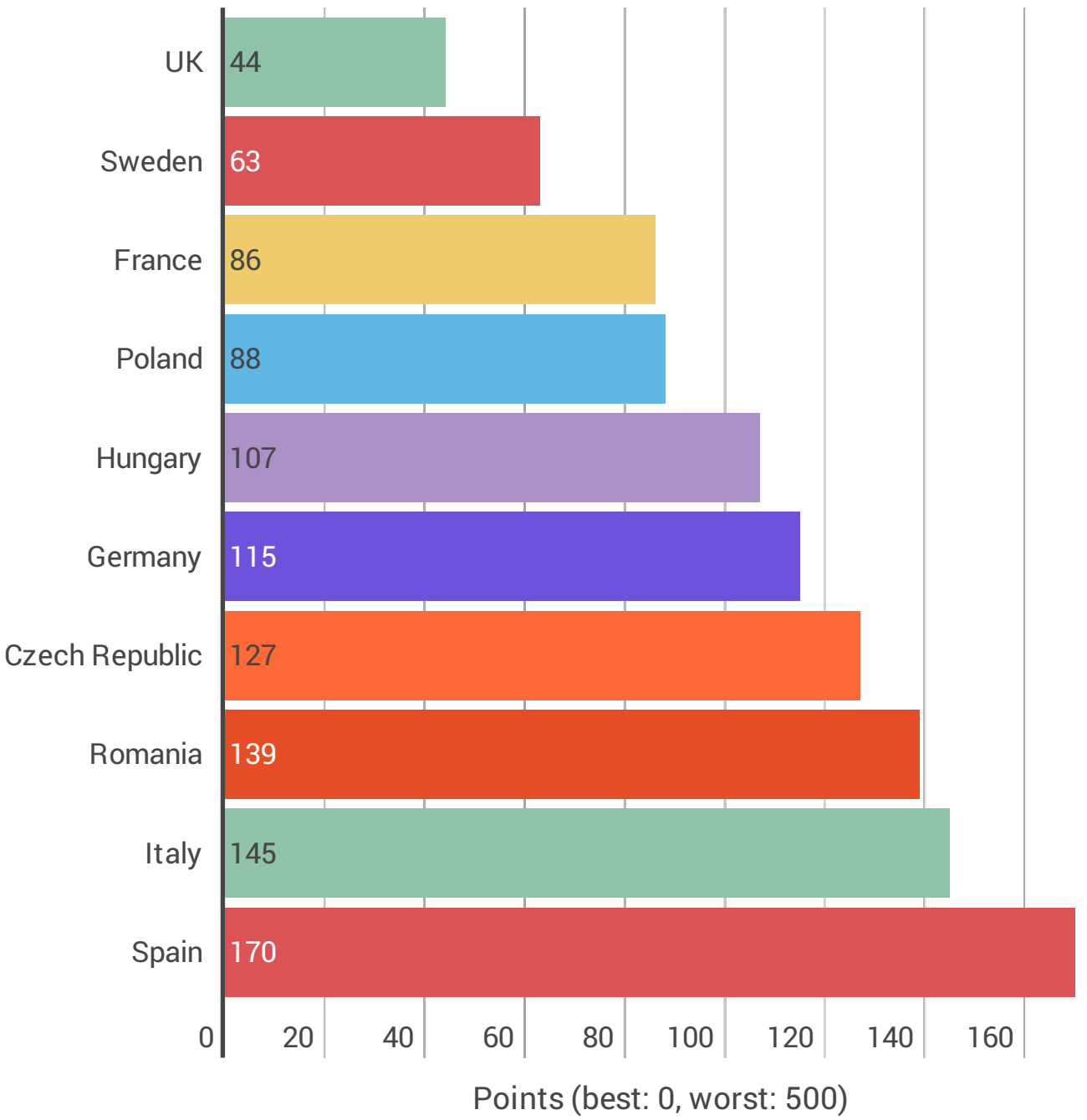


Corruption at EU Universities



Corruption at universities in certain European countries is perceived by their graduates to have reached serious proportions. A YouGov-survey commissioned by Milata KG surveyed 5.217 university graduates from 10 European countries. In the lowest ranked states, corruption is thought to be endemic in almost all major fields: admissions, marking, issuing degrees (including PhDs) and recruiting academic staff. It is the largest survey of academic corruption at European universities to date.
